
# Perry Park Emergency Evacuation Guide

## Keep the six "P's" ready, in case an immediate evacuation is required:


- People and pets
- Papers, phone numbers, and important documents
- <u>Prescriptions</u>, vitamins, and eyeglasses
- <u>P</u>ictures and irreplaceable memorabilia
- <u>Personal computers</u> (information on hard drive and disks)
- Plastic (credit cards, ATM cards) and cash



### **Evacuation Routes**

- 1. MAIN: Red Rock Drive to Perry Park Rd.
- **2. NORTHWEST:** North on Perry Park Blvd. to right turn on to Country Club Dr. to left turn on Remuda Ranch Pkwy. and go through the green gate to Dakan Road.
- 3. GOLF COURSE: North on Perry Park Blvd. to left turn on to Country Club Dr. to right turn on to Remuda Ranch Pkwy. and go through the green gate to Dakan Road.
- \* The route you take will depend on the fire location (stay away from the fire area) and direction by Emergency Services personnel.

# Perry Park Evacuation Guide

#### Be Prepared:

- 1. Register contact information for all your communication devices with **Code Red**, Douglas County's emergency mass notification system at <a href="http://www.dcsheriff.net">http://www.dcsheriff.net</a>. If you do not have a CenturyLink land line, you are not signed up to receive emergency notifications. You must register your devices with Code Red for any phone service through your cable provider. All cell phones must also be registered with Code Red.
- Make a list of important items to take during an evacuation. Think "PIP" - Precious, Irreplaceable, Portable:
- Phone numbers, Birth certificates, Insurance Paperwork, Tax Records and Other documents.
- Prescriptions, vitamins and Medical Necessities.
- Photo Albums, Jewelry, Memorabilia
- Laptops, backup Hard Drives, Other Digital Media, and Cell Phones.
- Credit Cards, ATM Cards, Cash
- Assemble an emergency supplies kit. Include adequate bottled water, non- perishable food, a change of clothing and shoes, hygiene items, a flashlight and extra car keys.
- 4. Have extra cash on hand. Keep at least 2½ times what it costs to fill your gas tank.
- 5. Perform a home inventory of important household items, electronics, furniture and other belongings. Take pictures and store the list with other

Valuable documents.

- If you have pets, arrange in advance for a place to take your animals. Have extra food, water, leashes, cat litter, and carriers on hand with your emergency supplies.
- 7. Ensure all family members are familiar with evacuation routes and plan a pre- determined location to evacuate to or meet.
- 8. Establish an out of area third party contact for family members to relay messages to each other

#### When to Leave

#### Don't wait to be told by Authorities to Leave!

Leave early enough to avoid being caught in fire, smoke, or road congestion. Leaving protects you from being hurt or killed. It also improves the chance for fire fighters to save your home and property!

#### When You Go

- 1. Close all doors, windows, and vents in your home.
- Lower/Close all shutters, blinds, or heavy noncombustible window cover- ings. Remove flammable drapes and curtains from windows (to avoid ignition from radiant heat).
- 3. Move any combustible deck furniture inside house or garage.
- 4. Park any unused vehicles in the garage.
- 5. Turn off propane tanks (BBQ grills, Heaters, etc) and move into garage.
- 6. Leave on all interior and exterior lights.
- 7. Leave garden hoses out with nozzle attached and water turned off.

#### **Evacuation**

 When evacuating protect yourself from heat and smoke by wearing sturdy shoes, a long sleeve shirt and pants. Consider a dust mask and goggles if necessary.

- Turn on your headlights and keep the windows rolled up.
- Be aware of incoming emergency vehicles and pull over to let them pass!
- Be Calm, Courteous, and Drive Safely!

#### **Evacuation Routes**

The route you take will depend on the fire location and directions given by Emergency Services Personnel.

Two routes have been designated as Perry Park evacuation routes as outlined on the back of this pamphlet.

To guide you in evacuation, look for, and follow, the Red & White "Wildfire Evacuation Route" signs out of the park.
